RUDOLPH IN THE SNOW, \$10 at Nic's Restaurant and Martini Lounge, Beverly Hills Mix equal parts white Godiva chocolate liqueur and Pravda vodka. Garnish with a candy cane. **Our take:** Oh, so *that's* how he got his red nose!

CHRISTMAS IN HAWAII, \$11 at the Nine Steakhouse at the Palms Resort and Casino, Las Vegas In a large glass coffee mug rimmed with sugar water, coconut shavings, and cinnamon, mix equal parts Kahlua, coconut rum, and bourbon. Fill the rest of the mug with coffee. **Our take:** It warms you up like a winter morning on a beach in Maui.

SUMMIT WINTER WARMER, \$9.75 at the Summit restaurant at the Broadmoor, Colorado Springs In a snifter, mix three parts Williams & Humbert 15-Year Solera Especial Oloroso Sherry, one part Lepanto Brandy de Jerez, and two parts lightly brewed mint tea. Add a quarter teaspoon wildflower honey and garnish with a twist of orange, a few whole cloves, a sprig of fresh mint, and a cinnamon stick. **Our take:** Never mind tea for two — you'll want this drink all to yourself.
